Understanding IDEA's Early Intervention and Special Education Processes and Services



This on-line session will provide pertinent information to navigate the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) Part C, Early Intervention Services (EIS) and IDEA Part B, Special Education Services Processes.
